How Important is Doing God's Will?

- *Luke 6:46 "Why do you call me, 'Lord, Lord,' and do not do what I say?"*
 - ⁴⁷ *I will show you what he is like who comes to me and hears my words and puts them into practice.*
 - ⁴⁸ *He is like a man building a house, who dug down deep and laid the foundation on rock. When a flood came, the torrent struck that house but could not shake it, because it was well built.*
 - ⁴⁹ *But the one who hears my words and does not put them into practice is like a man who built a house on the ground without a foundation. The moment the torrent struck that house, it collapsed and its destruction was complete."*
