Pleasing God

Ephesians 1:4 For he chose us in him before the creation of the world to be holy and blameless in his sight. In love ⁵ he predestined us for adoption to <u>sonship</u> through Jesus Christ, in accordance with his <u>pleasure</u> and <u>will</u>.

Psalm 149:4 For the LORD takes delight in his people; he crowns the humble with victory.

1 Cor. 10:31 So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God.

1 Thess. 4:1 As for other matters, brothers and sisters, we instructed you how to live in order to please God, as in fact you are living.

Pleasing God thru worship

Worship-

John 4:23 Yet a time is coming and has now come when the <u>true</u> worshipers will worship the Father in the Spirit and in truth, for they are the kind of worshipers the Father seeks. ²⁴ God is spirit, and his worshipers must worship in the Spirit and <u>in truth</u>. Psalm 27:4 One thing have I asked of the Lord, that will I seek after, that I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to <u>behold the beauty of the Lord</u> and to inquire in His temple.

Psalm 84:10 Better is one day in your courts than a thousand elsewhere; I would rather be a doorkeeper in the house of my God than dwell in the tents of the wicked. ¹¹ For the LORD God is a sun and shield; the LORD bestows favor and honor; no good thing does he withhold from those whose walk is blameless. ¹² LORD Almighty, blessed is the one who trusts in you.

Worship because of the gospel

John 3:16 For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him <u>shall not perish</u> but have eternal life. ¹⁷ For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but <u>to save the world</u> through him. ¹⁸ Whoever believes in him is not <u>condemned</u>, but whoever does not believe <u>stands condemned already</u> because they have not believed in the name of God's one and only Son. ¹⁹ This is the verdict: Light has come into the world, but people loved darkness instead of light because their deeds were evil.

Romans 5:8 But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

Pleasing God or pleasing people?

Galatians 1:10 Am I now trying to win the approval of human beings, or of God? Or am I trying to please people? If I were still trying to please people, I would not be a
servant of Christ.

Luke 14:26 If anyone comes to me and does not hate father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters—yes, even their own life—such a person cannot be my disciple.
